

  - One-year integrated LIC at Kaiser Permanente, Oakland (8 students)
  - Includes all core clerkships
- Longitudinal Integrated Fresno Experience (LIFE)
  - 6 month LIC at UCSF Fresno Campus (9 students)
  - Medicine, family medicine, neurology, psychiatry

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# **PISCES Program Costs**

- Co-directors: 10% FTE each (OME)
- Administrator: 50% FTE (OME) + 5% FTE from each participating discipline
- Discipline-specific liaisons: 5% FTE each (departments)
- Preceptor productivity (departments)
- Space: PISCES room, student rooms in clinics
- LICs offload traditional clerkships requiring less resources (PISCES accounts for 10% of the entire third year clerkships)



# WRITE Program Costs

- Program costs supported by Dean's office
- Site budget (24 students)
  - Administrative fee \$10,000 x 24
    - Faculty travel \$2,000 x 24
    - Housing \$5,000 x 24
    - Subtotal

### Administration

- Administrative Assistants (2)
- Faculty travel \$2,500 x 24
- Subtotal
- Total for 24 students \$468,000 +
  37.5 % Faculty FTE + 37.5% Administrative FTE
