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Goal of PCLT

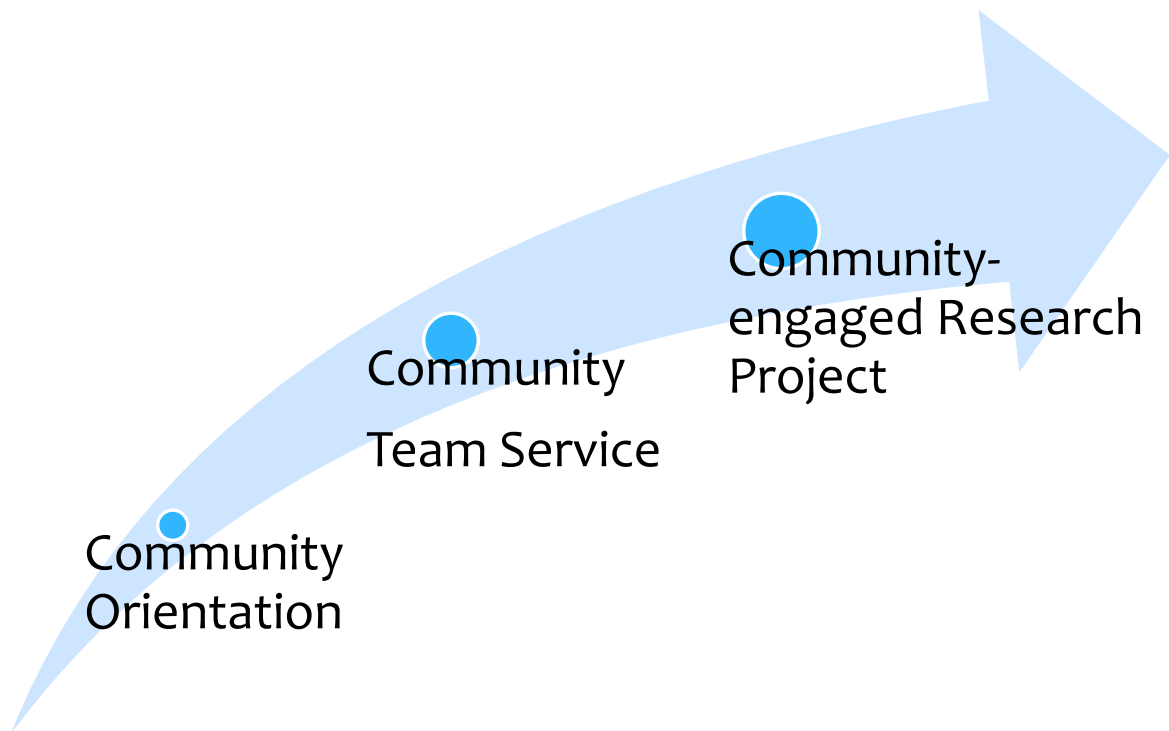
- * To improve the health of the public by preparing primary care physicians in:
